





ABHYASIKA अभ्यासिका

ICD, Tughlakabad Exports, Delhi Customs Zone has taken up 'Abhyasika' as a Swaachhta project. This is an innovative, self sustaining initiative that is not only based on felt need but also because of the immense promise and potential it holds to nudge children/students/youth from underprivileged to become



become contributing members of the society. The tagline of Abhyasika is "Towards Billion Dreams' which is indicative of the vision.



Many bright underprivileged children/students/youth in many localities /areas do not have the space, study environment or access to good study materials. Abhyasika is an attempt to bridge that gap by setting up a unique library cum study space. The space would be provided by locality/NGOs while we would provide infrastructure and books

(school, college, competitive exams). The USP of this project is that 'Abhyasika' will not only provide the study environment but would require that the children/students/ youth sit and study in the Abhyasika. It is unique library in the sense Abhyasikas will provide access to recommended guide books and study materials but will not lend any books/study material. The Abhyasikas will eventually be linked to mentors online.

A dedicated website <u>www.abhyasikaacustoms.com</u> has been created to monitor he progress and output and the same is functional.

To begin with, we are setting up Abhyasikas in 20 locations which would be scaleQd up in days to come and successful candidates from different Abhyasikas will be mentors for others to make this a selfsustaining initiative.

On 28th February, 2022, 19 Abhyasikas were inaugurated by Shri Surjit Bhujabal, Chief Commissioner of Customs, Delhi Customs Zone physically at Boudh Vihar, Near Police Station, PulPrahladpur, New Delhi and virtually in 18 locations in Delhi NCR and Meerut.

DHRISHTI SE SRISHTI दृष्टि से सूष्टि

ICD Tughlakabad Import has initiated "Drishti se Srishti" project in September 2021 under which 5 blind schools/organizations have been identified for renovation and development work for the financial year 2021-22 under the Swachhta Project. This has been done based on the vision of Hon'ble PM on Swachh Bharat. An



outreach program under the guidance and support of Shri Surjit Bhujabal, Chief Commissioner, Delhi Customs Zone was initiated by ICD TKD Import Commissionerate of Delhi Customs. The project Drishti se Srishti is a splendid example of his leadership and inspiration which has made the project a success. The idea of approaching Blind Schools for their genuine needs on infrastructure fronts under the project "दृष्टि से सृष्टि" aims to bring about meaningful and long lasting impact in the lives of needy.





These schools/organizations and the respective renovation and development work undertaken are as under:

The project "दृष्टि से सृष्टि" has imparted a convenient and safe learning zone for these blinds and induced a sense of equality in them. Being a part of such initiatives has also given a sense of satisfaction making us realize that we have played a significant role in motivating these blind persons.

The project 'Drishti se Srishti' was inaugurated by the Chief Commissioner of Customs, Delhi Zone on International Women's Day at NAB India Centre for Blind Women and Disability Studies, Hauz Khas, New Delhi one of the sites of the Project and the representatives of all the 05 Schools were felicitated and a small video of the project was showcased.

























SAJAL सज्ल

The jurisdiction of ICD Patparganj Commissionerate in Delhi Customs zone extends to the state of Haryana. In Haryana, Central Ground Water Board, Department of Water Resources, Ministry of Jal Shakti, Government of India, in its report in October 2021 on state of ground water in Haryana, has highlighted that the ground water offerings in different



districts of Haryana are mostly saline, and not suitable for drinking purposes. The report also highlighted that the water has low potable rating as chemical parameters were much higher than permissible limits.




The permissible pH limit of drinking water as per BIS 10500 (2012) standard is 6.5 to 8.5. However, the pH limit is exceeded beyond 8.5 in most districts, going up to 9.0. Calcium with a permissible limit of 200, as per the BIS standard, is up to 650. Magnesium with a permissible limit of 100, as per the BIS standard, is up to 700. Chloride with a

permissible limit of 1000, as per the BIS standard, is up to 5000. So, considering the salinity and dissolved solids and chemicals beyond permissible limits, the ground water is not safe for drinking.

Based on this ground situation, the Commissionerate took an initiative under Swachhta project to provide safe drinking water facility to school students under the Project SAJAL, meaning full of water. Clean Water leads to Complete Development.

The aim is to provide safe drinking water to school students, which will enable the schools to have a nurturing environment for students to have their studies and activities. For this enablement, two technologies are identified–Reverse Osmosis (RO) to lower dissolved solids within permissible limits and Water Cooler to provide drinking water during hot summer months when temperature exceeds 40 degrees Celsius in Haryana. In the RO process, the feed water enters the RO membrane under pressure, the water molecules pass through the semi-permeable membrane and the salts and other contaminants are not allowed to pass and usually more than 95% of the dissolved salts are removed from it.





The RO removes common pollutants from water including nitrates, lead pesticides, sulfates, fluoride, bacteria, pharmaceuticals, arsenic, chlorine and chloramines. RO filtration improves taste, odor and appearance of water by removing contaminants. The hot potable water during summer months of blistering heat is not conducive to drink. The technology of water cooler keeps it in normal range for students to quench their thirst.





With this goal, 20 government schools are identified in different districts of Sonepat, Panipat, Faridabad, Palwal and Gurugram. These schools are located in rural areas with industrial belts where the ground water is contaminated due to industrial discharge and as suggested by the Central Ground Water Board.

The R.O. water purifiers along with the Water Coolers have been dedicated to the students on 26.04.2022 giving them round the year access to clean potable water, during a launch at Sonipat by the Chief Commissioner of Customs Delhi.

All 20 Schools and their Principal participated in a virtual launch at each location. This facility will nurture students' health, helping their complete development in a clean environment and 8000 students will benefit from this unique initiative by Delhi Customs.

Work has been often equated to worship, making office space a temple of deeds. Besides a Custom Officer spends a huge portion of his day in office while utilising office space. A clean works place generates positive vibes and motivates the occupant to keep a clear mind and achieve his goals.

Thus, with an aim to improve and provide healthy environment/working space and better amenities to the Officers/staff working in the Commissionerates, various projects were undertaken by the Commissionerates of Zone as detailed below:

Fixing Of Pavement Of Tiles On The Side Walk At New Customs House:

The walkway around the New Customs House building was not properly managed as in the half walkway cement tiles were installed leaving behind half which demonstrates a bad visual expression outside of the building. Further at many points of the walkway, tiles were broken and used broken furniture and glass goods were placed all round. The Pavement tiles have been installed in the all the walkway around the New Customs House Building. Keeping in view the beauty of the building, tiles were installed all around the building. The project was started on 30.09.2021 and completed on 07.10.2021 by the General Commissionerate of Airport & General, Customs Delhi Zone.





Renovation Of Conference Hall Of New Customs House:-

Conference hall in the NCH building is one of the most important place in the NCH building which is used by the senior officers for meetings with the staff members and members of trade. The conference hall was renovated with wooden flooring, wall panelling, new windows with blinds and electric wire connections were installed.



Further, a new big LED screen has been installed which is compatible to all updated software for video conferencing. The project was started on 23.11.2021 and completed on 24.01.2022 by the General Commissionerate of Airport & General, Customs Delhi Zone.





Construction Of Library And Repair Of Cha Lobby At New Customs House:-

The work of installation of lift is in progress in NCH building, due to which 2-3 officer's and staff room were shifted. Subsequently, the CHA space was optimized and a new library along with renovated CHA Hall was carved out.



New chairs and wooden furniture were installed in the

newly constructed library. Further chairs, wooden flooring and false ceiling with LED lights and lockers has been fixed in the CHA lobby for the facility of the visitors. Both projects were started on 16.04.2021 and completed on 26.07.2021 by the General Commissionerate of Airport & General, Customs Delhi Zone.

Renovation Of Office Canteen At New Customs House:-

Canteen is the place where hygiene is utmost priority. It is said that health of a family depends on kitchen. Under Swachhta project, Office Canteen of the NCH was renovated. Flooring, tiling, white washing and fixing of wash basin etc works were done. A room was also constructed in the Canteen. This project was undertaken by the General Commissionerate of Airport & General, Customs Delhi Zone.





Maintenance Of The Green Wall At The Main Gate Of New Customs

Plants are the greatest natural cleaner available in our environment apart from being a life line for human being. Hence, it was felt that what better solution would be for Swachhta Action Plan than Green Plants. In pursuance of the above, a green wall/Vertical Garden was installed at the main




Renovation Of Hall 237 B At New Customs House:

Renovation Of Bond Section In Acc (export) Commissionerate At Nch:-

This room which accommodates staff of three, along with frequent visit from Customs Brokers and trade, was in very dirty and dilapidated condition. The walls, window & ceiling plaster was dirty and flaking off. The furniture too was old and in state of disrepair. The room setting was in disarray due to old misfit table, chair almirah etc., degrading further by loose electric wiring and board fitting. The task was not only sanitation, but also, beautification and complete transformation of the room, as it was also a public place, and first impression of the office.

The walls & ceiling was painted/plastered, damaged furniture was discarded and with a view to re-set the room, work stations were erected for comfortable ambience for staff to work, and with proper seating arrangement for the visitors. Now, the room is unrecognizable from its previous look.





Installation Of Ro System In Acc Export Commissionerate At Nch:-

The provision of the pure drinking water is paramount in any Swachhta drive. It was felt that potable water facility available in the office is not adequate, & commensurate to the needs of the staff, and to frequent

visitors from trade. The already placed water cooler/dispenser at the ground floor of NCH was old, rusted and beyond repair. The staff was averse to using it, due to fear of infections.

The staff was averse to using it, due to fear of infections. The scarcity of potable water would likely to be aggravate in the upcoming summer. With a view to overcome this, idea of installation of water purifier/cooler was adopted.

Renovation Of Stairs At New Customs House:

The stairs on the left side of the entrance to the main building of the New Custom House were in a dilapidated condition. There was always the risk of visitors falling and getting hurt. The work of renovation of these stairs was completed by ACC Import Commissionerate of Delhi Customs under Swachhta Action Plan.





Renovation And Beautification Of Gallery At First Floor Of Nch:-

ACC Import Commissionerate of Delhi Customs has undertaken the project of first floor Gallery showcasing the freedom struggle from 1857 to 1947. The gallery was further extended to incorporate women freedom fighters, Sardar Vallabh Bhai Patel, National Emblems etc. Under Swachhta assessment special campaign for disposal of pending matters the Department of Administrative Reforms and Public Grievances (DARPG) had selected the New Customs House as office under Central Board of Indirect Taxes and Customs for Swachhta assessment. DARPG while assessing the best practices of different Ministries has submitted that various positive steps were undertaken highlighting the corridor to the women freedom fighters and another corridor devoted to India's freedoms struggle. As part of the drive, father of the Nation, Mahatma Gandhi's ideas of cleanliness, his portraits and glimpses from life work showcased in the corridors. This office attempted to inculcate the lessons of freedom struggle among the school children by arranging special tour programs. The Doordarshan team has also covered the gallery in a documentary produced by them.









Renovation Of Various Rooms At Icd Tughlakabad Import Commissionerate Of Delhi Customs:-

The various rooms of the office premises at ICD Tughlakabad Commissionerate were in deplorable and dilapidated conditions due to which the officers were not able to perform their duties properly so this Commissionerate undertook the Renovation, Repair and Developmental work of the following rooms under Swachhta project.

- (i) Renovation, Repair and Development Work in Room No.111 of the Office premises.
- (ii) Renovation of Room No.20, 115 and 125 of the Office premises.
- (iii) Renovation of Room No. 118,119 and pantry work in the Office premises.
- (iv) Whitewash of the Office premises, painting of Doors, Pots and Fire Extinguishers on Ground and First Floor of the Office Premises. After the completion of project, the rooms have become hygienic, robust, clean & tidy thereby producing an atmosphere for maximum output by officers.





Renovation Of Rooms Of Icd Tughlakabad Export Commissionerate Of Delhi Customs:-

The plants and pots were kept in the office premises of ICD Patparganj Commissionerate and were also distributed to Sarvodaya Kanya Vidyalaya, Ghazipur under Swachhta project with a aim to create a healthy environment in the office premises and reduce the effects of pollution on our health.

Distribution Of Jute Bags Among The Staff And Others To Replace Plastic Bags:-

Delhi customs has always been vigilant toward its social obligation. A helping hand was extended to various schools and other institutions of Delhi by various Commissionerates of Delhi Customs as detailed below:

Renovation of washroom of Sarvodaya Kanya Vidhyalaya:

The Customs Commissionerate, Airport & General, has adopted Sarvodaya Kanya Vidhyalaya, New Delhi for reconstruction and renovation of girl's washrooms as a special project under the Swachhta initiatives. The girl's washroom was in a dilapidated condition and was completely ruined with no doors, roof was completely broken. Further as the school is for girl child it is our moral and social responsibility to provide them a safe, healthy and hygienic environment. The project was taken on priority basis and today the washroom is completely repaired and renovated with all necessary amenities are installed. The project was started on 07.10.2021, completed on 24.01.2022 and was inaugurated on 31.01.2022. Further it is pertinent to mention here that Principal Ms. Ruchi Tandon, HOS, SKV, New Delhi vide letter dated 12.01.2022 has thanked the Commissioner (A & G) for the generosity of the work done by the Customs formation.





Renovation Of School At Rajokari, New Delhi:

As part of the special drive the cleanliness and renovation of South Municipal Corporation Nigam Pratibha Balika Vidyalaya, Rajokari, New Delhi was taken up for renovation by Air Cargo Complex (Import) Commissionerate. The repairing of the broken/damaged walls was made and paint of walls of the school was completed. The tiles



in the inner and outer walls of the ground floor rooms were fixed which has changed the ambiance of the building.

Vermipost Project At Sarvodaya Kanya Vidyalaya, Dalipura, Delhi:

Vermicomposting is a unique process based on earthworms (red worms) and micro-organisms, whose joint action provides degradation and detoxification of organic waste into useful agronomic products. Vermicomposting can be done in small spaces. The presence of vermicompost in soil may act as a soil conditioner by supplying nutrients to the plants, lowering C to N ratio, improving the



soil texture, increasing soil porosity and water holding capacity thereby requiring less tillage and irrigation. This project was undertaken by ICD Patparganj Commissionerate at Sarvodaya Kanya Vidyalaya, Dalipura, Delhi.

Renovation Of Toilet At Icd Tughlakabad Export Commissionerate Office:



Digitalization Of Office Records:
