Subject: 2nd Phase of All India roll-out of Faceless Assessment – reg.

Kind attention of the Importers/Exporters, Custom Brokers, Airlines/Agents, Logistic Service Providers, Custodians, Trade and Other Stakeholders is invited to the Public Notice No. 3/2019 dated 23.09.2019 and CBIC Circular No.28/2020-Customs and Instruction No. 09/2020, both dated 05.06.2020 on the 1st Phase of All India roll-out of Faceless Assessment under the umbrella of the Turant Customs programme. It was rolled out for items of import primarily covered by Chapters 84 and 85 of the Customs Tariff Act, 1975.

2. It has been decided to begin the 2nd phase of All India roll-out of Faceless Assessment w.e.f. 03.08.2020 by including Delhi and Mumbai Customs Zones and extending the scope of Faceless Assessment at Chennai and Bangalore Customs Zones. It is clarified that the Customs Zones and the imports already covered under the 1st Phase would continue and be treated as subsumed under the 2nd phase. Thus, the 2nd phase of Faceless Assessment will cover the imports primarily under the specified Chapters of the Customs Tariff Act, 1975 as under:-



3. Further, for monitoring and ensuring speedy and uniform assessments in the Customs Zone, in regard to Bills of Entry assigned by the Customs Automated System to the officers of the Faceless Assessment Groups, Principal Commissioner/Commissioner of Customs, ICD Tughlakabad, Import and Principal Commissioner/Commissioner of Customs, Air Cargo Import, Delhi are hereby nominated as Nodal Commissioner who shall be administratively responsible for monitoring and ensuring speedy and uniform assessments in the three Customs Zones namely Chennai, Bengaluru and Delhi in regard to Bills of Entry assigned by the Customs Automated System to the officers of the Faceless Assessment Groups.

4. Further, in terms of Notification No.63/2020-Customs (N.T.) dated 30.07.2020 issued for the purpose of empowering the Commissioners of Customs (Appeals), Delhi shall take up appeals filed in respect of Faceless Assessments pertaining to imports made in his jurisdiction even though the assessing officer may be located at the other Customs station. To illustrate, Commissioner of Customs (Appeals), Delhi shall have jurisdiction to decide appeals filed for imports at Delhi though the assessing officer is located at Chennai or Bengaluru.

5. All other clarifications and guidelines on Faceless Assessment, as provided vide Board's Circular No.28/2020-Customs and Board's Instruction No.09/2020-Customs, dated 05.06.2020 and the Public Notice No. 3/2019 dated 23.09.2019 issued by this office and Public Notices issued in pursuance of the same by the Commissionerates, may kindly be referred to.

6. Any difficulties faced in the implementation may please be brought to the notice of the above mentioned Nodal Officer(s).


