The Commissioner welcomed all members and began by expressing her appreciation to the stakeholders of Committee for continued efforts and involvement in the process of collective decision-making and resolving operational issues. The Commissioner suggested that it would be better if other agencies like Drug Controller General, Wild Life Authority etc. also attended the PTFC meeting for collective and speedy redressal of problems, if any, faced by the trade.

2. This PTFC meeting is the first meeting post Budget 2014-15. During the course of discussion, the Commissioner was glad to announce that the strength of Superintendents in the Import Sheds is being enhanced as a measure of trade facilitation. The custodian DIAL and DCSC were asked to make necessary arrangements at the earliest for providing adequate space and necessary infrastructure for the IFO.

3. Representatives of Customs Brokers pointed out that generally there has been delay in release of consignments on account of activities related to Budget. They requested for waiver of demurrage. The custodians representative affirmed that they will positively consider the same.

4. The meeting was concluded with a vote of thanks to the Chair and with a request to the PTFC Members to submit Agenda items in advance with detailed proposal for the next meeting. It is decided that the next meeting will be held on 19.08.2014 at 11.30 hours in the Committee Room.
