At the outset, Sh. G. S. Karki, Additional Commissioner welcomed all the members and requested for introduction of members as some new officers had joined. All the members introduced themselves.

As no agenda points had been received from the members prior to the meeting, Sh. G. S. Karki, Additional Commissioner asked the members to raise any issue that was required to be discussed.

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The following points were taken up in the meeting:

Point No.1 : Shri Kailash Gupta, Hony. Secretary, DCCAA raised the previously discussed issue of problem of printers at Import Shed. He pointed that though there is less work load nowadays, there is consistent problem of printers at the Shed.

Reply : Shri Rajeev Shankar, Assistant Commissioner (Import Shed) informed that he had already taken up the matter with HP and pursuing to get it resolved at the earliest possible. Shri G. S. Karki, Additional Commissioner of Customs suggested the A.C. (Import Shed) to pursue the matter both with the Directorate of Systems/HP and the Custodian as providing logistic support is supposed to be taken care of by the Custodian.

Point No. 2 : Shri Kailash Gupta of DCCAA also raised the issue of poor quality of printouts particularly the small font size being generated through the systems.

Reply : Shri G. S. Karki, Additional Commissioner of Customs suggested the A.C. (Import Shed) to take up the matter with the Directorate of Systems.

Point No. 3: Shri Kailash Gupta of DCCAA further raised an issue that once on-line out of charge is given and message to that effect has been transmitted, Gate pass is not issued till hard copy is not generated.

Reply: The representative of CELEBI said that he would look into the issue.

Point No.4: The representative of BAR (I) enquired whether hard copy of e-delivery is required to be taken as they are in the process of introducing e-delivery and e-freight.

Reply : Shri G. S. Karki, Additional Commissioner of Customs said that as it was a policy matter, any decision in this regard cannot be taken at Commissionerate level.

Point No.5: The representative of BAR (I) further raised an issue that there are a few items which are required to be cleared immediately but are held up for want of segregation report. He further added that earlier they used to file Kachcha Bill of Entry for such items.
