At the outset, the Commissioner welcomed all the members. As no Agenda points for the meeting had been received prior to the meeting, the Commissioner asked the members to raise any issue that is required to be discussed.

The following points were taken up in the meeting:

**Point No.1:** The Commissioner enquired about the action taken on repeatedly raised issue of problems of printers at the Shed.

**Reply:** Sh. Ramesh Mami Dala, COO of CELEBI informed that all the five printers installed at the Shed are functioning well and that further procurement was being made and the same would take another couple of weeks.

**Point No. 2:** Sh. Sushant Nigam, General Manager, DIAL raised an issue as to whether it can be made possible that once Customs clearance has been given and EDI message transmitted to the effect, the final printouts may be taken by the Importers at their places as it would reduce lot of time consumption.

**Reply:** The Additional Commissioner (Import Shed) informed that the matter had already been taken up with DG (Systems) and they are working on the issue.

The Additional Commissioner (Import Shed) further informed the members that efforts are already on to put in place a system of displaying information about different stages of the activities taking place at the Shed and also informed that the First-in-first-out (FIFO) facility would be ensured for not only taking printouts but also for the clearance of cargo. He further added that M/s CELEBI was already in the process of renovation to provide required logistic support for the same.

The Commissioner asked the representative of CELEBI as to when the renovation activities would be completed. The representative of CELEBI informed that it would take one more week

**Point No. 3:** Sh. Shalendra Jain, Vice President DCCAA raised an issue regarding 24 x 7 operation being introduced for clearance that the allied agencies i.e. Wild Life Authorities, ADC, P&Q, etc. should also be made available 24 x 7 as their services would be required for the same.

**Reply:** The Commissioner replied that as the decision to introduce 24 x 7 facilities has been taken at the highest level, all the stakeholders have been involved. In the meantime, she suggested the ADC (Import Shed) to take up the matter with the local officers of the departments.
